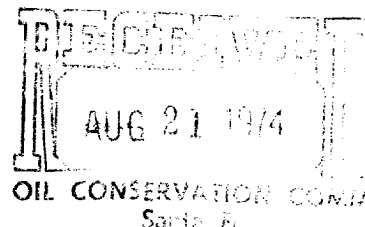

Dear Sir:

Request is here made for an exception to the well location requirements for a well Northern Minerals, Inc., proposes to drill in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 29, T16N-R6W, McKinley County, New Mexico. The well will be called Northern Minerals, Inc., No. 15 SFPRR Company.

The regular location for this well would be 2310' FNL and 2970' FEL of section 29. Such a location falls in the Chico Arroyo. See accompanying map. For topographical reasons, therefore, It is requested that permission be granted to drill the well 2405' FNL and 2805' FEL of section 29. This location is on the south side of the Arroyo. See attached plat.

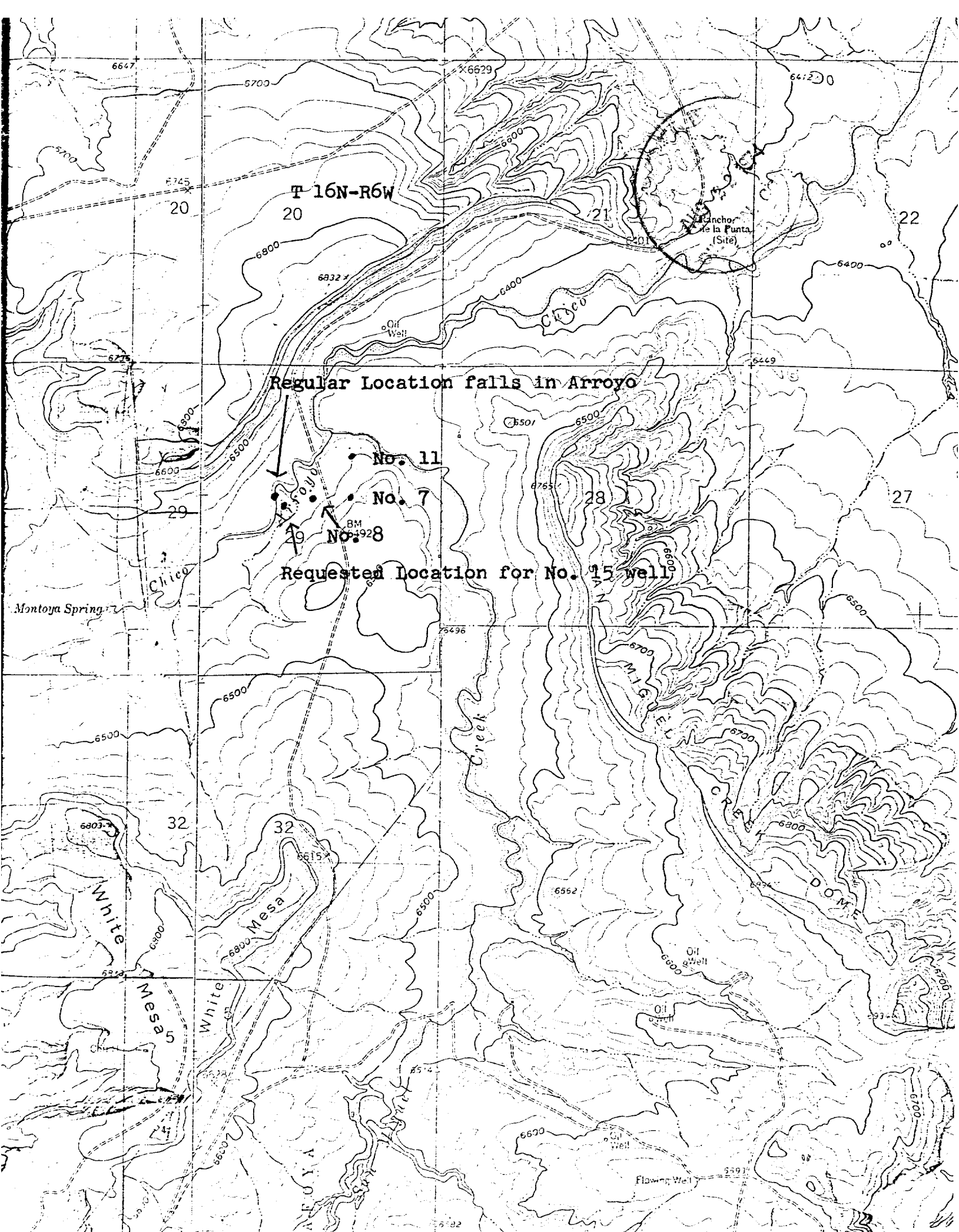
Northern Minerals, Inc., owns an oil and gas lease executed by SFPRR covering all of section 29. Hence, there are no offsetting lease owners to the proposed location.

Northern Minerals, Inc., No. 8 SFPRR well is located 2310' FEL and 2310' FNL of section 29; it's No. 7 well is 2310' from the North Line and 1650 FEL; and it's No. 11 well is 1650 FNL and 1650 FEL of said section. These wells offset to the east the proposed location for the No. 15 SFPRR well.

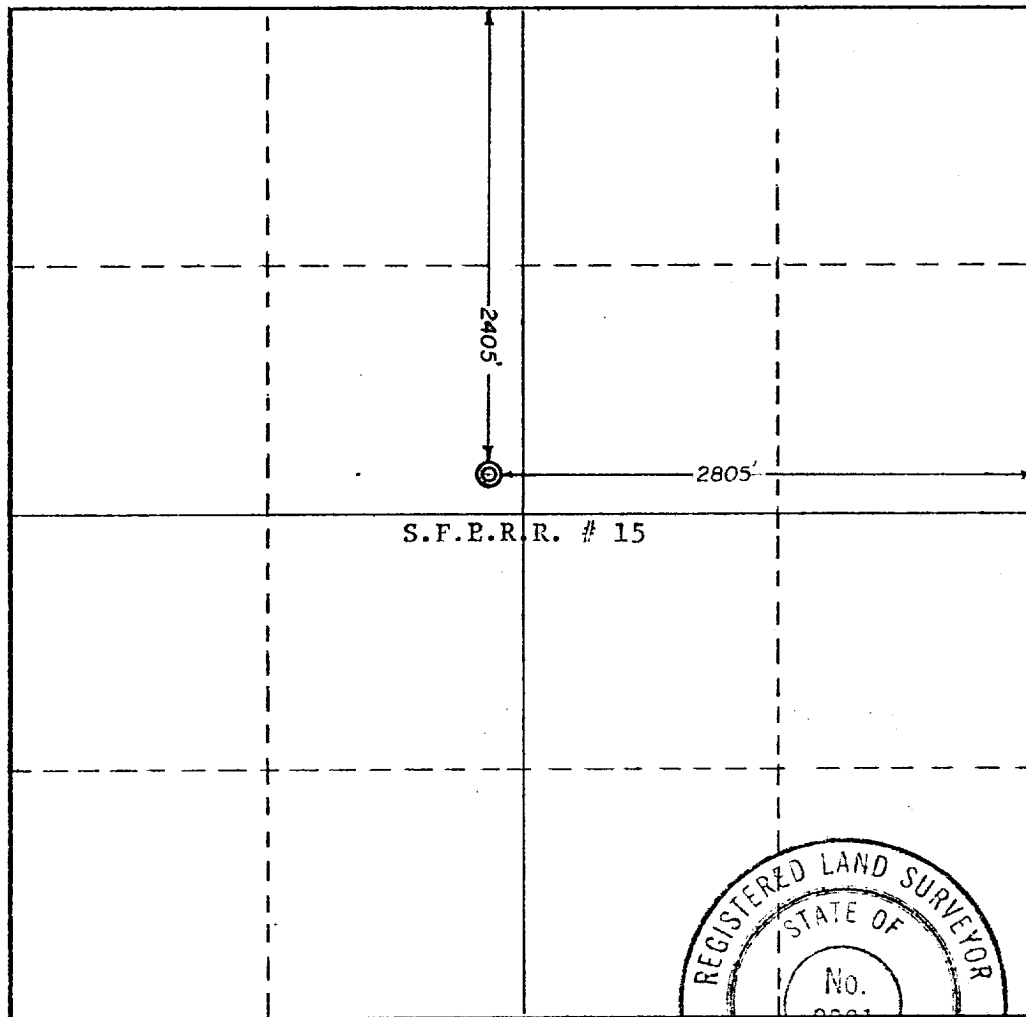
