STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE

I, Morris D. Young (Name of Signatory party) President (Title) do hereby state:

(1) That I pay or supervise the payment of the persons employed by Envirotech Inc. (Contractor or Subcontractor) on the digging of 17 abandoned wells that during the payroll period commencing on the 14th day of January 1901 And ending the 00th day of January 1901 all persons employed on said project have been paid the full weekly wages earned, that no rebates have been or will be made either directly or indirectly:

to or on behalf of said Envirotech Inc. (Contractor or Subcontractor) from the full weekly wages earned by any person and that no deductions have been made either directly or indirectly from the full wages earned by any person, other than deductions permitted by law.

Anyone found in violation of the New Mexico Public Works Minimum Wage Act [15-11 to 13-17 NMSA 1978] could be subject to penalties and debarment.

(2) That any payrolls otherwise under this contract required to be submitted for the above period are correct and complete; that the wage rates for laborers or mechanics contained therein are not less than the applicable wage rates contained therein for each laborer or mechanic conform with the work he performed.

(3) That any apprentices or trainees employed in the above period are duly registered in a bona fide apprenticeship program registered with the State apprenticeship agency recognized by the Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training, United States Department of Labor, or properly enrolled in a bona fide training program approved for application on public works construction projects by the appropriate state (SAC) and/or federal agency(ies) (BART) if and as required by law and applicable federal regulation.
