ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on March 8, 1978, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner, Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this 11th day of April, 1978, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That Saguaro Oil Company is the owner and operator of the Tenneco Santa Fe Well No. 1, located in Unit D of Section 31, Township 18 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, McKinley County, New Mexico.
- (3) That in order to prevent waste and protect correlative rights said Tenneco Santa Fe Well No. 1 should be plugged and abandened in accordance with a program approved by the Aztec bistrict Office of the Old Conservation Division of the New Mexico Energy and Minerals Department on or before June 1, 1978, or the well should be returned to active drilling status or placed on production.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That Saguaro Oil Company is hereby ordered to plug and abandon the Tennoco Santa Fe Well No. 1, located in Unit D of Section 31, Township 18 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, McKinley County, New Mexico, or in the alternative, to return the Well to active drilling status or place the Well on production on or before June 1, 1978.
