Moved in completion rig 9-18-75. Ran correlation log 9-19-75. Perforated with 2 shots per foot from 1728' to 1731', from 1733' to 1735', and from 1736' to 1742'. Went in hole with tubing, swabbed well. No fluid entry.

Perforated with 2 shots per foot from 1664' to 1668', from 1680' to 1691', and from 1702' to 1704'. Set packer at 1710', acidized with 500 gallons 7 1/2% HCL. Breakdown - 1400 p.s.i., back to 800 p.s.i. Started recovering acid water. Released completion rig at 4:00 p.m. 9-20-75.

Instructions
