Referencing the attached BLM letter of May 18, 1987, Texaco has not performed the Menefee recompletion proposed on the April 8, 1986 Sundry Notice. Texaco Inc. could not obtain proper co-owner approval to perform the workover. The Federal 15-2 is still uneconomical to produce and has remained shut in due to economics. Texaco is currently in the process of initiating a sale of the well and requests BLM approval to leave the subject well shut in. Should the potential sale fail to materialize, a Sundry Notice will be filed with Texaco's future plans for the Federal 15-2.
