Dear Mr. Ludwick:

By letter July 2, 1979, we requested a Sundry Notice report concerning your re-entry plans for Well No. 1 Star Lake, located in the NE/4NE/4 sec. 26, T. 20 N., R. 6 W., NMPM, McKinley County, New Mexico, on Federal oil and gas lease NM-5981. Sundry Notice report has not been received in this office within the allotted time so approval of Application for Permit to Re-enter is rescinded this date.

Application for Permit to Re-enter was approved March 21, 1979. By letter June 27, 1979, the Bureau of Land Management notified us that restoration of the well location by the previous operator was satisfactory, and on July 10, 1979, the Subsequent Report of Abandonment submitted by the previous operator was approved. Any surface disturbance which you may have made will need to be restored to the satisfaction of the Bureau of Land Management.

If at some later date you decide to drill a well at this location, it will be necessary to file a new application.
