

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your well No. 1 IRMA, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 35, T. 19 N., R. 5 W., McKinley County, New Mexico, lease NM-6999. The above-mentioned well was plugged on June 27, 1980. An intent to re-enter the well was approved on June 30, 1981, and was extended 90 days from October 14, 1982. The extension has expired as of January 14, 1983. The well has not been re-entered as discussed with Claude Kennedy on January 14, 1983. Therefore, the well remains in a plugged and abandoned status. Any surface disturbance not previously completed must be completed prior to approval of abandonment.
