NMOCD monthly production reports (form C-115) show the referenced wells are being injected into at pressures exceeding the pressure limits. The #49 at 640 PSI with a limit of 320 PSI and the #92 at 423 PSI with a limit of 300 PSI. Some type of remedial action must be taken. You may wish to change your injection pattern or you may wish to apply with the Division Director for pressure limit increases. Five more of your wells are slightly over their limits. You should be able to keep these within limits by slightly decreasing the flow to them.
