GARY BLANKS, being first duly sworn according to law, upon his oath deposes and says:

1. That he is Vice President of Capital Oil and Gas Corporation

whose address is P. O. Box 2130, Kilgore, Texas 75662.
2. That Capital Oil & Gas Corporation is the operator of a well drilled on land be-

longing to Fernandez Company, Ltd., whose address is San Mateo, New Mexico 87050
(Landowner)

Capital Oil & Gas Corporation, said well being drilled to test for hydrocarbons and/or carbon dioxide gas and described as the S.F.P.R.R. No. 61, being located 330 feet from the West line and 2310 feet from the North line of Section 20, Township 16 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, McKinley County, New Mexico.

3. That said well was drilled to a total depth of 1536 feet, and that casing has been set and cemented as follows: 10/27/81 - 4-1/2" 9.5# casing was run to 1535 feet. 175 sx of class "H" cement was pumped and circulated to surface.

4. That operator and landowner have made an agreement whereby operator (is) (is not) to back fill pits, level location, and clear it of all junk. The agreement further provides that operator is to plug said well back to a plugged-back total depth of 1535 feet and transfer well to landowner for his use as a water-well. Operator will leave casing in the well as follows:

Operator will leave 1535 feet of 4-1/2" 9.5# casing in the hole.

5. That when operator has complied with the provisions of Paragraph 4 above it will so notify the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico on Commission Form C-103, together with a signed statement from the landowner that the provisions of Paragraph 4 above have been complied with to his satisfaction.

C-103 was filed on 4/20/82 and 1/3/83.
