Dear Mr. Woods:

The referenced wells have been shut in by our office due to noncompliance of our rules and regulations. NMOCD Rule No. 313, states that tank bottoms shall not be allowed to pollute streams or cause surface damage. If the tank bottoms are removed to surface pits, the pits shall be fenced and the fence shall be kept in good repair. When you have complied with NMOCD Rule No. 313, I will recommend that the referenced wells be returned to production and the transporter will be advised to recommence purchase of products.
