7/3/74 Rigged up Chesney Drilling Company rig 24 at 5:00 P. M. Spud at 5:30 P. M. Air drilled 5" hole to 270' at 7:45 P. M. Picked up core barrel. Cut core No. 1 from 270-281.5' with air. Core barrel jammed. Came out of hole. Laid down core and went in hole. Cut core No. 2 from 281.5' to 300.5' with air. Came out and laid down core barrel. Went in with open ended drill pipe and spotted 40' cement plug on bottom (4 sks). Filled hole with mud and spotted 2 sks surface plug. The foregoing plugging procedure was telephonically approved by Emery C. Arnold, Oil Conservation Commission in Aztec. Job complete at 11:30 P. M. on 7-3-74.

Before me, a notary public, Lloyd Davidson, whose signature appears below, stated that this well was plugged so as to confine permanently any water, oil, and gas in the separate strata originally containing them. 7/30-74.
