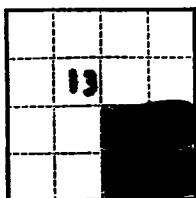

DETAILS OF WORK

Subject well spudded June 23, 1962. Set 100' of 8 5/8" surface casing and cemented with 60 sacks. Total depth of 3075' reached June 26, 1962. 4 1/2" casing set at 3075' and cemented with 100 sacks. Well was perforated from 2981-3015' and sand fraced July 1, 1962 with 40,000 # sand and 40,000 gallons water.

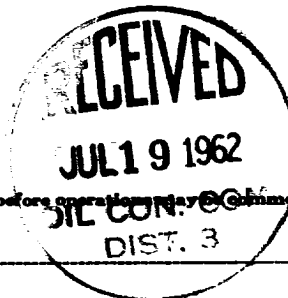
Well presently emitting testing.
