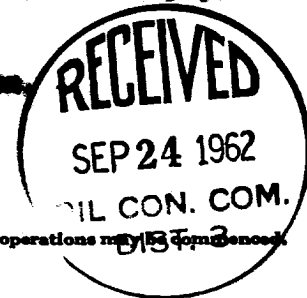
DETAILS OF WORK

Subject well spudded September 3, 1962. Set 105' of 8 5/8" surface casing and cemented with 60 sacks. Total depth of 3030' reached September 6, 1962. Set 4 1/2" casing at 3037' and cemented with 100 sacks. Well perforated at the intervals 2975-2990' with 2 shots per foot, and 3030-3036 with 2 shots per foot. Well sand fraced on September 11, 1962 with 30,000 sand and 30,000 gallons of water.

Well presently awaiting pipeline connection.
