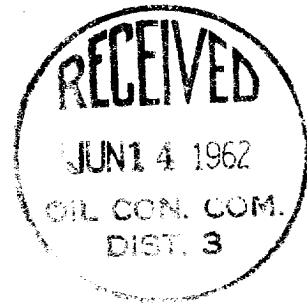

Under date of March 27, 1962 a Communitization Agreement covering the above captioned acreage was submitted to the U. S. Geological Survey in Roswell, New Mexico for approval.

This Agreement was executed by the following people as to the following acreage.

1. Tract No. 1. SF 080515, NW/4 NW/4 Section 7 - 23N - 1W  
owned by Elizabeth Ann Elliott.
2. Tract No. 2. Martha M. Morelock Lease, S/2 NW/4 Section 7  
Township 23N - Range 1 W (fee lease)
3. Tract No. 3. SF 080515-B, NE/4 NW/4 Section 7 - 23N - 1W  
owned by George H. Hunker, Jr.

According to the U. S. Geological Survey inasmuch as Tract No. 1 contains only 36.20 acres and Tract No. 3 contains 36.30 acres, added together along with Tract No. 2, makes a total of 152.50 acres. It is my understanding that our company will need evidence of the Commission's approval of a non-standard spacing unit.

Would you kindly advise as to the procedure and all forms necessary to obtain this approval so that I may re-file the Communitization Agreement once again for approval.
