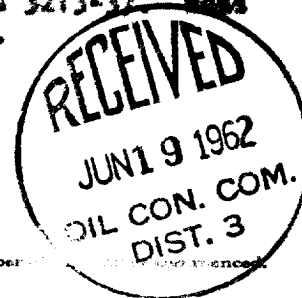

DETAILS OF WORK

Subject well spudded April 15, 1962. 94' of 8 5/8" surface casing was set and cemented with 60 sacks. Total depth of 3,269' was reached April 23, 1962. and 4 1/2" casing was set at 3,268' and cemented with 125 sacks.

Subject well was perforated at the intervals of 3150-66' and 3213-37' and was sand fraced on May 4, 1962. Presently awaiting testing.
