DETAILS OF WORK

Subject well spudded April 4, 1962. Set 98' of 8 5/8" casing and cemented with 60 sacks. Electric Log ran to total depth of 3374'. 4 1/2" casing was cemented at 3374' with 100 sacks. Subject well was perforated at the intervals 3314'-3326' with 2 shots per foot and 3334'-3350 with 2 shots per foot. Treatment pressure 1950 psi at 37.88PM. Well sand-fraced with 30,000# 20/40 sand on May 17, 1962. Well presently shut-in awaiting pipeline connection.
