We have filed 6 copies of notice of Intention to drill (Form 9-331B) to amend location for our Jicarilla No. 3-2, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, previously filed by letter of May 1, 1956.

The amended location falls at an unorthodox location being 415' FSL and 745' FWL of Section 2, T-23-N, R-4-W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, it has been moved due to the topographic condition of the previous locations.

In compliance with Rule 104 (f), section 2b of the Rules and Regulations, a waiver has been granted by Southern Union Gas Company, only off-set Operator to the proposed location waiving their objections to the proposed location and is here filed with the Commission.

We respectfully request approval to drill our Jicarilla No. 3-2 at the proposed unorthodox location, to test the Pictured Cliffs at a total depth of 3300'.
