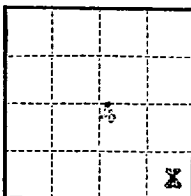

DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill this well with rotary tools to approximately 2250' to test the Pictured Cliffs formation. Approximately 300' of 8 5/8" surface casing will be set and cemented to surface. If commercial production is encountered, a string of 4 1/2" production casing will be set and cemented on the well completed.
