DETAILS OF WORK

Ran 49 joints 9-5/8-inch casing, 2151.73 feet, set at 2164 feet. Cemented with 700 sacks 8% gel and 100 sacks neat cement. Plug on bottom at 2145 P.M., 4-22-55. (Circulated approximately 100 sacks. Slurry weight on 8% 14 to 14.2, neat 15.5 to 15.7#.

Tested casing at 7:00 A.M., 4-24-55 with 1000# for 30 minutes. Test O.K. No drop in pressure.

Now drilling.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
