DETAILS OF WORK

Subject well was spudded April 23, 1962. 98' of 8 5/8" surface casing was set and cemented with 50 sacks. Total depth of 3200' was reached April 30, 1962. 4 1/2" new casing was set and cemented with 100 sacks on May 1, 1962. Well was perforated at the intervals of 3110-18' 3152-72' and 3184-96. Well was then sand water fraced on May 4, 1962 with 40,000# of 20/40 sand. Subject well presently awaiting initial test.
