Dear Sir:

I request that you permit me to drill at an unorthodox location because of unfavorable topographical conditions. I have been designated operator of all of Section 1-23N-1W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, and I desire to drill a 2500' wildcat test, to be known as the Kelly Federal #1, at the following location:

2355' from the south line and 1510' from the east line, Sec. 1-23N-1W

This location is in the NW/4 SW/4 of the section. Because of unfavorable topographical conditions the proposed location is the only suitable well site in this quarter quarter section. As I am the operator of all direct and diagonally offsetting 40 acre tracts there are no other lease owners whose consent is required.

Enclosed you will find copies of form C-128 (Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat) concerning the proposed unorthodox location.
