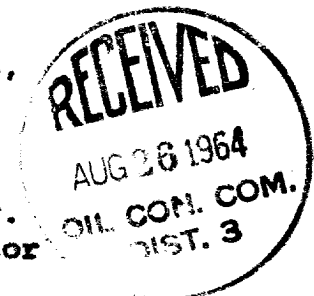
Dear Mr. Beeler:

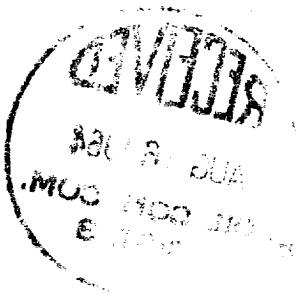
