May 16, 1975 Moved in workover rig and pulled tubing. Squeezed Pictured Cliffs perforations 3284-3301' with 200 sacks cement. Drilled out cement and drilled 60' of new hole to TD of 3380'. Ran 2 1/2" perforated liner and set from 3290-3380'.

June 9, 1975 Frac treated down casing with 39,360 gallons of gelled water and 40,000# of 20-40 sand. Injection rate 42 BPM and Treating pressure 1200 psi.

July 25, 1975 Swabbed well in and flowed to pits for 3 days to clean up frac water.

July 29, 1975 Shut in for pressure build up and test.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
