Penumbarger perforated Pictured Cliffs formation from 3162' to 3112' with 2 shots per foot.

Wellbore fluid-water frac Pictured Cliffs formation with 35,430 Gals. water and 40,000 20-40 Ottawa Sand thru above perforations. Break down press. 1700, min. press. 1700 and max. press. 1750. Instant shut in 500, 5 min. shut in 300. Treating Injection Rate 12 Gals. per min. when finished well flowed back est. 200 gals. of water and no sand.

Run 2-1/2" log., bet at 3096'. Swabbed well for 3 hrs. After making 8th trip well started flowing w/350' log. press. and 200' log. press. Closed well in for build up press. Well completed at 7:00 PM 5/22/64.

5/23/64 - took 3 hr. test, on 3/4" log. Choke w/log. press. 2622, log. press. 5762, Gas Vol. 3,348 MCF/daily. Casing and log. pressures equalized at 1000 when shut in.
