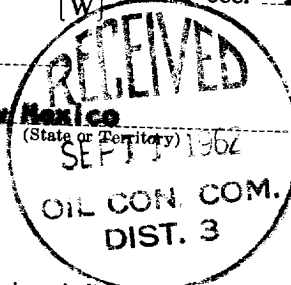

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Subject well spudded August 3, 1962. Set 95' of 8 5/8" surface casing and cemented with 60 sacks. Total depth of 3140' reached August 7, 1962. Set 4 1/2" casing at 3095' and cemented with 100 sacks. Perforated from 3007' to 3022'. Sand fraced August 13, 1962, with 30,000# sand. After fracing job, swabbing operations were commenced and a slight trace of oil was recovered. 1" tubing was run to 3010' and well was shut-in for a 24 hour period to allow it to pressure up. On August 22, 1962 well was opened and the well flowed by heads recovering approximately 40 barrels of oil and 100 barrels of water. Well died and we are presently awaiting to move in a larger completion rig for additional testing.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
