Our records indicate that the well listed above is inactive and not in compliance with Rule #201.B.

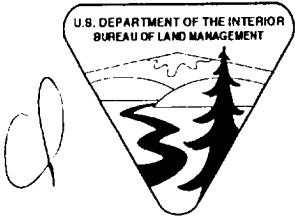

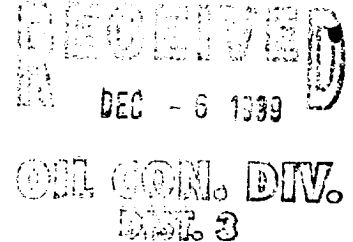

Dear Mr. Reynolds:

Communitization Agreement (CA) NMNM 95813 was approved effective April 3, 1996. This agreement communitized lots 3, 4, SENW, SWNW, section 5, T. 24 N., R. 1 E., NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, for crude oil and associated natural gas from the Mancos formation. The CA encompasses 158.19 acres, comprised of 79.15 acres of land in Federal lease NMNM 33036 and 79.04 acres of fee land.

The term of the agreement is for two (2) years and so long thereafter as communitized substances are, or can be produced from the communitized area in paying quantities.

As of the date of this letter, no response to our certified letter dated August 20, 1999, has been received. Therefore, the CA is considered to have terminated by its own terms as of November 31, 1996, the last day of the month in which the Arellano #1 well produced from the communitized formation. The well is located on FEE land.

Under provisions of 43 CFR 3165.3 you may request an Administrative review of the orders described above. Such request, including all supporting documents, must be filed in writing within 20 business days of receipt of this notice and must be filed with the State Director, Bureau of Land Management, P.O. Box 27115, Santa Fe, NM 87502-7115. Such request shall not result in a suspension of the order(s) unless the reviewing official so determines. Procedures governing appeals from instructions, orders or decisions are contained in 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR 4.400 et seq.
