Spudded well 1-5-64. Set 8 5/8" surface casing at 99' and cemented with 60 sacks. Plug down 1:00 P.M. 1-6-65. Total depth 2930' reached 19-9-64. Set 4 1/2" casing at 2923'. with 100 sacks. Guide shoe at 2930', insert float at 2929'.

On January 20, 1964, ran correlation log from 2530-2923'. Ran cement bond log from 2100-2918'. Perforated from 2889 to 2899 with 10 holes. On January 22, 1964, perforated 2812-2816 with 4 holes. Set cast iron bridge plug at 2800'. Swabbed well down to 2250'. Swabbed well dry. Well made some gas, lots of water. On 2-25-64, perforated 2768 to 2795 with 27 holes. Squeezed perforations with 75 sacks cement.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
