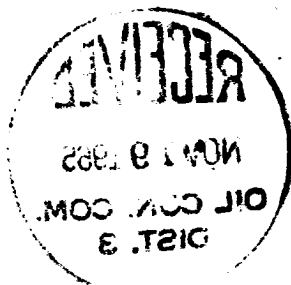

We have just received in this office a copy of Administrative Order NSL-364, which is in error. I have referred to our copy of your application for approval of the non-standard location and determined that they evidently were confused as to exactly what your new location was to be. As I understand it, it is your intention to plug the Jicarilla D 156 Well #1, which is located 1850 feet from the North and 1850 feet from the East Line of Section 11. The 1-X well is not located on your application plat with reference to the section line. I presume that it would be 2540 feet from the North and 2540 feet from the East Line.

I believe that your application should be re-filed, showing the location with respect to section lines. Your application letter should also contain more specific information as to the topographic conditions in the area which make the non-standard location necessary. The application should also refer to the #1 well and contain some explanation as to why the second location is being drilled on this quarter section. I am sending a copy of this letter to Mr. James Durrett, the Commission Attorney in Santa Fe and requesting that NSL-364 be voided. A new order will be issued upon receipt of your new application.

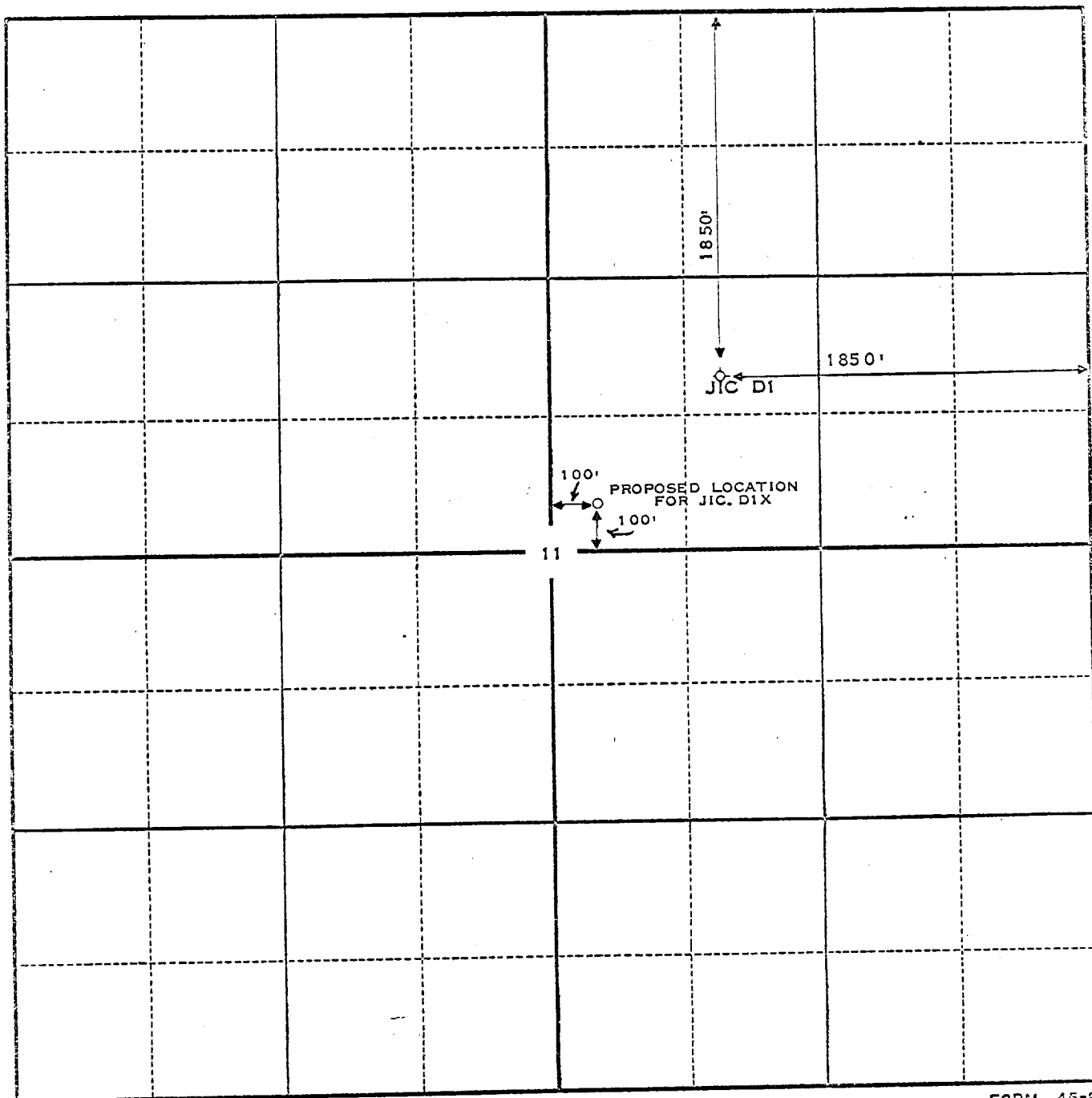

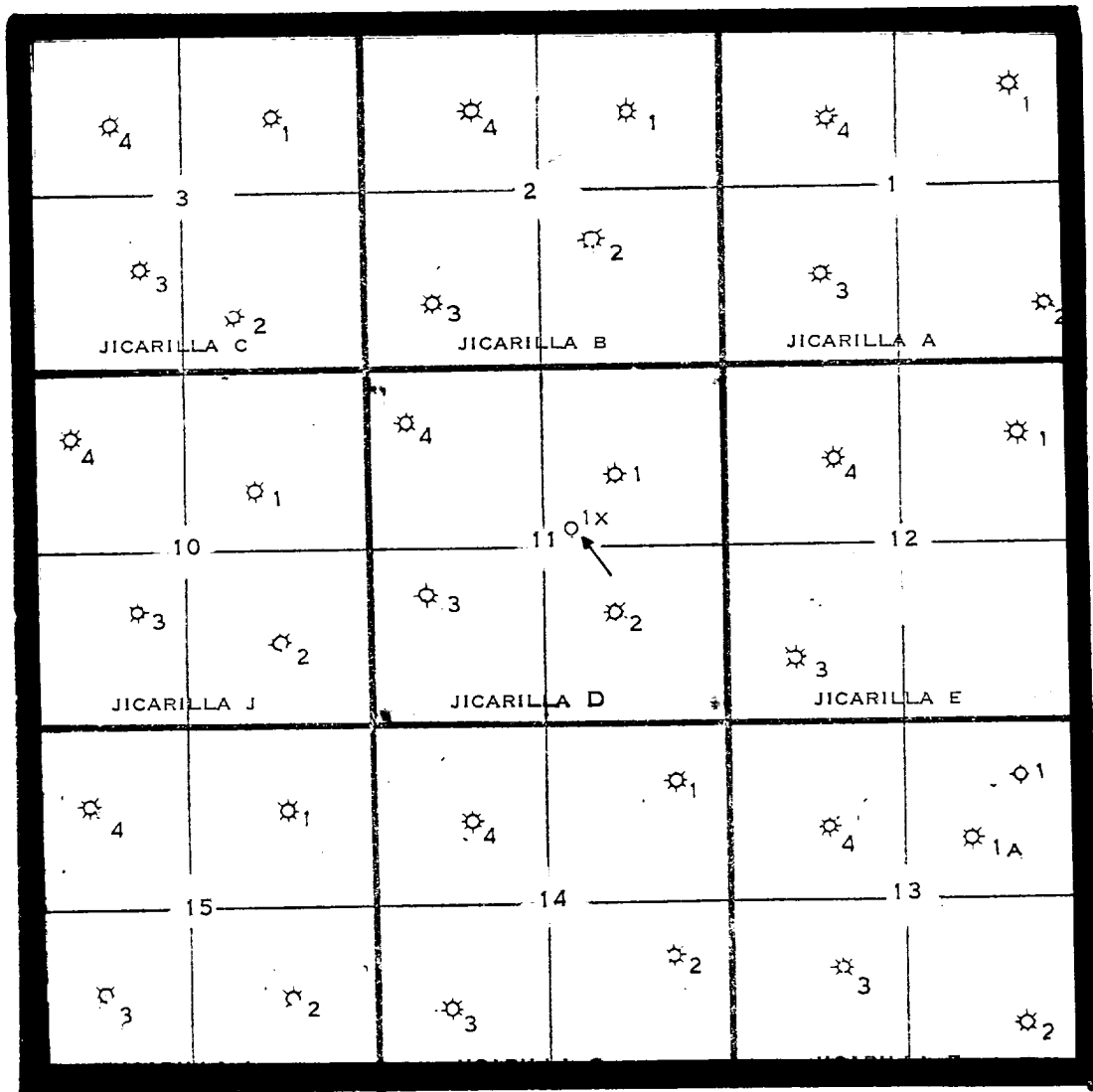
