This material enclosed is the information I spoke to you about over the phone, Wednesday, 4-4-73.

I have enclosed one copy of the oil and gas leases signed, by the three of us, Nickson, Sigmon and myself. We have only a total of 6% of the well.


Mrs. Franks called and told us you had given permission to drill the new well within four feet of the old hole and that they ~~had~~ permission to do so for atleast two weeks. They plan to start the new hole by the 15th of this month. She was not told over the phone that you had said they had not asked, nor would you give your permission for such a drilling. She made the last phone call to Mr. Sigmon on Thursday, 4-5-73.

We would appreciate your looking over this material and especially the letter from Mr. W. D. Stricklin and letting us know your findings.

Anyone can drill a dry hole, our concern is the manner in which this was and is being handled and if they can legally close out their investors in this manner.

We would appreciate hearing from you at your earliest convenience.
