Pricing: The minimum price to be paid by Gas

adjustments for BTU and taxes. The
maximum price being controlled by a
favored nations clause, as to other
purchases made by Gas Company of

New Mexico.

Term: Six (6) months and thereafter until terminated by written notice.

If the above changes are acceptable to you, we would appreciate your preparing a contract for our approval.

For your information, we have recently completed the Gallup formation in this well and it appears that it is going to produce at a rate of about 200 MCF per day. This added to our estimates of 300 MCF per day for the Greenhorn-Dakota formation, will make our combined delivery about 500 MCF per day assuming the oil commission allows us to co-mingle the two zones.
