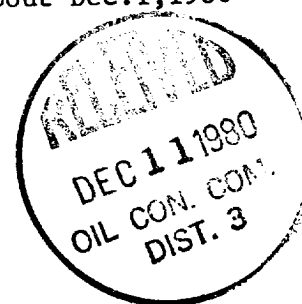

This well was drilled in conjunction with our State H #4 Well and our Dunn Federal #3. The Dunn #3 is making quite a bit of water and we therefore set a E-Z Drill cement retainer on this well at 6453 on 11-28-80 in order to temporarily abandon the 3rd Dakota (6503-09) which we believe is making most of the water on the Dunn #3 and would probably on this well. This will allow us to isolate and produce the Upper Graneros perforations (6326-31) during the winter and in the spring we can either plug the bottom perfs thru the E-Z drill or we can drill it out and place the bottom perfs back in production.

The above procedure was explained in more detail to Frank Chavez on or about Dec. 1, 1980 by phone.
