sides prior to drilling activity and closed off on the fourth side after drilling is finished. The reserve pit will be lined with an 8-12 mil "poly" liner if required.

- 10. Plans for Reclamation of the Surface: Prior to releasing the rig from the location, the reserve pit will be completely fenced for protection of livestock and wildlife until the pit has dried and is backfilled and leveled. Restoration activities will begin immediately after completion of the well and the backfilling, leveling and contouring should be completed within 90 days from the commencement of such activities or as weather permits. Upon completion of the drilling activities, all disturbed areas not utilized for on going production activities will be graded to the original slope and contoured as nearly as is practicable and the topsoil that is stripped and stockpiled will be spread over the area. All waste and trash will be disposed of at an approved landfill. The reserve pit will be allowed to dry prior to backfilling and recontouring. Upon completion of the backfilling, leveling and contouring of the site, the location will be re-seeded at the appropriate time with the BLM recommended seed mixture and the equipment will be painted with the BLM designated color.
- 11. Surface Ownership: The surface and mineral rights are owned by the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management (BLM).
