Dear Mr. Chavez:

Commission Order R-6929 authorizes BCO, Inc. to commingle production from the Graneros and the Gallup on the wells listed above.

We have tested the two wells and recommend that the production be allocated according to the same formula we have used on other wells covered by this order. We propose that oil production be allocated with 25% to the Undesignated Graneros and 75% to the Lybrook Gallup. We found very little gas when we tested the Graneros. We believe a 2000 to 1 ratio for Graneros gas is accurate. The remainder of the gas will be allocated to the Gallup.

It is our opinion that the above allocations closely approximate the actual production from the two zones.
