Gentlemen:

This is the sixteenth weekly report of operations on the subject well and covers the time period from January 16, 1988 to January 22, 1988.

1/16/88 TD 9681' Ran 2 7/8" tubing with packer at 7075' md to test the Dakota from 7445' md to 9681' md. Began swabbing.

1/17-20/88 TD 9681' Swabbed well from 7000' md. Recovered a total of 177 bbls of fluid of which 3.5 bbls was oil. Discontinued test. POOH. Changed rams in BOP's to 3 1/2" DP. Tested BOP's 250/2500 psi-ok. Now picking up 3 1/2" DP.

1/21/88 TD 9681' Circulated at bottom of 5" liner, 9662'. POOH. Ran Howco selective injection packers with 11' between cups.

1/22/88 TD 9681' Washed open hole with 400 SCF nitrogen per bbl of KCl water from 7455' md to 9662' md. Now preparing to spot acid.

Fluid in hole is 8.5 ppg KCl water. Well is in testing and completion phase.

This well is being drilled as a "Tite Hole" and this report should be kept confidential.
