



Dear Mr. Chavez:

BCO, Inc respectfully requests administrative approval to drill the above referenced well in a non-standard location. An orthodox location is not possible because of topographic restrictions.

The topography consists of a hillside sloping upward on the south side of highway 44. This hillside is dominated by rocks and drainage arroyos which are 50-75 feet wide and 15-20 feet deep.

In addition to the terrain features which prevent construction there are three beautiful ponderosa pines on the hillside. Ponderosa pines are scarce in this area and we do not wish to disturb these trees.

A topographical map which shows the terrain features is presented as Exhibit "F". The orthodox window and proration unit are mapped in Exhibit "E".

Attached is a copy of the APD and the exhibits required by Bill LeMay's memorandum 1-90. A list of exhibits follows this letter.

Directional drilling is not feasible to reach a legal bottom-hole location. Straight hole drilling economics are marginally profitable (rate of return less than 15%) and an additional \$48,083 in horizontal displacement costs would kill the project by bringing the rate of return down below the cost of money.

Additionally, beam lift may be required to produce this well. Beam pumping operations in deviated holes are very complex and sometimes uneconomical.

Offset operators have been notified of our application. A notification affadavit which includes a list of the operators and a sample letter are provided in Exhibit "G". Please note that the proposed location is unorthodox only with respect to our own acreage and the correlative rights of the offset operators are protected.






