

DETAILS OF WORK

Subject well spudded July 1, 1962. Set 96' of 8 5/8" surface casing and cemented with 60 sacks. Total depth of 3220' reached on July 5, 1962, 4 1/2" casing set at 3217' and cemented with 125 sacks. Subject well was perforated from 3124-3144 with 40 shots, and was mud fraced on July 30, 1962 with 30,000' sand.

Well presently shut-in for testing.
