Notice of Intention to Drill was filed for your #1 State well in Unit D, Section 2-23N-2W in August, 1961. Later Form C-103 was filed showing that the well was spudded on 8-28-61 and that surface casing had been set and cemented.

Nothing further has been received on this well to show to what depth it was drilled and whether or not production was obtained. New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rules require that miscellaneous reports on all operations be filed within 10 days after completion of each operation. Will you please indicate the present status of this well. If the well is completed, Form C-105, Well Record form should be filed immediately. If the well was dry we will issue plugging instructions prior to final abandonment.

The oil conservation program in New Mexico is being administered by the Oil Conservation Commission, which was created by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Act, Chapter 100, Laws of 1935.
