By letter of September 3, 1954 I notified the Albuquerque Associated Oil & Gas Company of New Mexico that we could not approve plugging on their #1 Vigil well until Form C-105, Well Record, had been filed and form C-103, Report of Plugging, had been filed showing that the well had been plugged back and successfully completed as a water well. We do have on file the affidavit filed by Mr. Vigil saying that he accepts the well as his and the future plugging responsibility; however as I see it Albuquerque Associated cannot be released under the plugging bond unless the well is either plugged or transferred to a bonded individual. I do not believe that Mr. Vigil has a plugging bond; therefore I would hesitate to approve cancellation of Albuquerque Association's bond until they have set a cement plug as they indicated they intended to do and converted the well to a water well.
