(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

First Plug - 300' cement plug in bottom hole to 5710'.
Second Plug - 200' cement plug from 4600 to 4800'.
Third Plug - 200' cement plug across shoe on 8-5/8" casing 4320 to 4120'.
Cut off and recover as much 8-5/8" casing as possible.
Fourth Plug - 200' cement plug across top of 8-5/8" casing.
Fifth Plug - 200' cement plug across shoe on 10-3/4" surface casing from 590 to 590'.
Sixth Plug - 20' cement plug in top 10-3/4" casing, (surface casing)

Fill all intervals between plugs with mud latex fluid.
Place marker in accordance with New Mexico State Regulations.
