Dear Caswell:

We have received your letter of January 18, 1957 requesting plugging information on the F. F. Kelly #1 State in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 32-18N-4W:

This well was plugged in two stages. Before the rotary moved off the hole a 10-sack plug was set from 3650-80 and from 3380-3410 and 1020-1133. Operator then moved on cable tools and perforated and tested the following intervals: 450-65; 680-90; 864-78; 930-60. After this testing cast iron bridging plugs were set at 525', 750' and 900' and a plug of cement and rock was placed from 390' to 525'.

The well was then released to the landowner for the purpose of completing as a water well.
