Gentlemen:

You are the record lessees of Federal oil and gas lease N.M. 088979-B. This lease, dated May 1, 1960, has been considered extended by reason of production from the No. 2 Rollins-Dodgen well located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 28, T. 18 N., R. 3 W., Sandoval County, New Mexico.

Your Lessee's Monthly Reports of Operations indicate the subject well has not produced since July 1967, during which month it produced 48 barrels of oil. Your reports since that date show the well has been shut down for maintenance.

More than sufficient time has been allowed for repair of the well. You are, therefore, requested to arrange a production test of the well within the next 30 days and notify this office so that the test may be witnessed to confirm the ability of the well to produce. If the test is not arranged, this office will consider the well incapable of producing in paying quantities as of August 1, 1969.
