letter of 7/17/69, I would like you to please call me.

After receipt of your letter, I called your office to speak with you. You were out of town, I talked with Mr. [redacted] in producing the well.

The production in production month was very poor due to pump failure. At that time, the crew was unable to get another after a previous shut down due to pump failure. A breakdown again on a similar pump caused the pump cups to fall out. After this, the pump was being run at a cost of such work being done, it was decided to stop work due to financial and personnel problems. It was then decided to let the contractor in Cuba, Inc. who had been working on the well to Farmington, N.M. and do the work there. It was then possible to get engineers with experience in the area to do the work and the cost of getting an engineer from the U.S. was less than the cost of the work. Consequently, the well was shut in.

In Texas, we will have the next 3 days, time to get the equipment and the well back up to operating condition. We will then contact our contractor in Farmington and the expense of getting the equipment to Farmington. If this is feasible, I will have the contractor do it, however, we will have to see if it is possible. Since we have been working on the well, we of course don't want to

get the equipment and have to wait a week or so, after it is delivered, to get the equipment up and running a day and a half.

We will contact you the next week or two whether or not we can get the equipment and the required work to be completed. The contractor will be most appreciated.
