By agreement of the Farmington office I made a deal with Mr. Johnny Myers for the plugging of the wells on this lease and cleaning up of same for the equipment. Mr. Myers has been contacted and he states that the Gartner # 3 well was plugged September 4, 1968 as follows.

Well was plugged from total depth to 900' with sand between plugs. Plug 600 - 700 and 150 -250. Set surface plug and marker.

This lease was purchased from Mr. J I Harvey and I presume that he filed any logs he ran at the time he drilled this well.

## Instructions

**General:** This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

**Item 4:** If there are applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

**Item 17:** Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
