DETAILS OF WORK

Surface casing has been set to a depth of 32 feet with 8 5/8" diameter, 32 lb. A.P.I. pipe being used for this purpose. Approximately 6 sacks of cement were used and under pressure to obtain a complete water seal. Casing was set to 891 feet using 5 1/2" 14 lb. J-55 A.P.I. pipe. This casing was set by Dowell using Sealment and complete water shut-off was reported to above 460 feet. Production since this date has shown no excessive amount of water over the original amount reported for the first 24 hour test.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
