DETAILS OF WORK

This well was started on March 21 and completed April 20, 1959.  
It was drilled to the Mancos shale at a depth of 918 feet.  
Two oil sands were drilled and 5 1/2", 14 lb. casing was set to 891 feet. Sewell cemented the well on April 15 using 500 gallons of cement. Pumping was started at 8 A.M. and completed at 11:44 A.M. with a final casing pressure of 400 lbs. Complete water shut-off is reported, with cement placed above 4608 feet.

Well was completed as an oil well, 2" tubing was placed to a depth of 910 feet. Pump jack and tank have been installed and well is in testing production.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
