DETAILS OF WORK

This well was drilled by John Fidel and Associates, from 0' to 1201'; ran electric log then set 7" casing 1190' cemented w/200 sacks cement. Ed W. Cannedy took over the well at 1201' and started drilling deeper on May 23, 1956 and drilled to 1304' where he encountered a bad caveing condition and was unable to go deeper with cable tools. He shut the well down June 9, 1956 at the total depth of 1304' and is temporarily abandoned at that depth.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
