DETAILS OF WORK

Propose to drill 13 3/4" surface hole; set 120 feet 9 5/8" surface casing circulated to surface with cement. Drill 7 7/8" hole to approximately 5,000 feet to test Dakota formation. Surface formation Kirtland shale; Pictured Cliffs at 400 feet; Cliffhouse at 1,000 feet; Point Lookout at 2,600 feet; Gallup at 3,800 feet; Dakota at 4,600 feet. If successful, plan to run 5 1/2" production string.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

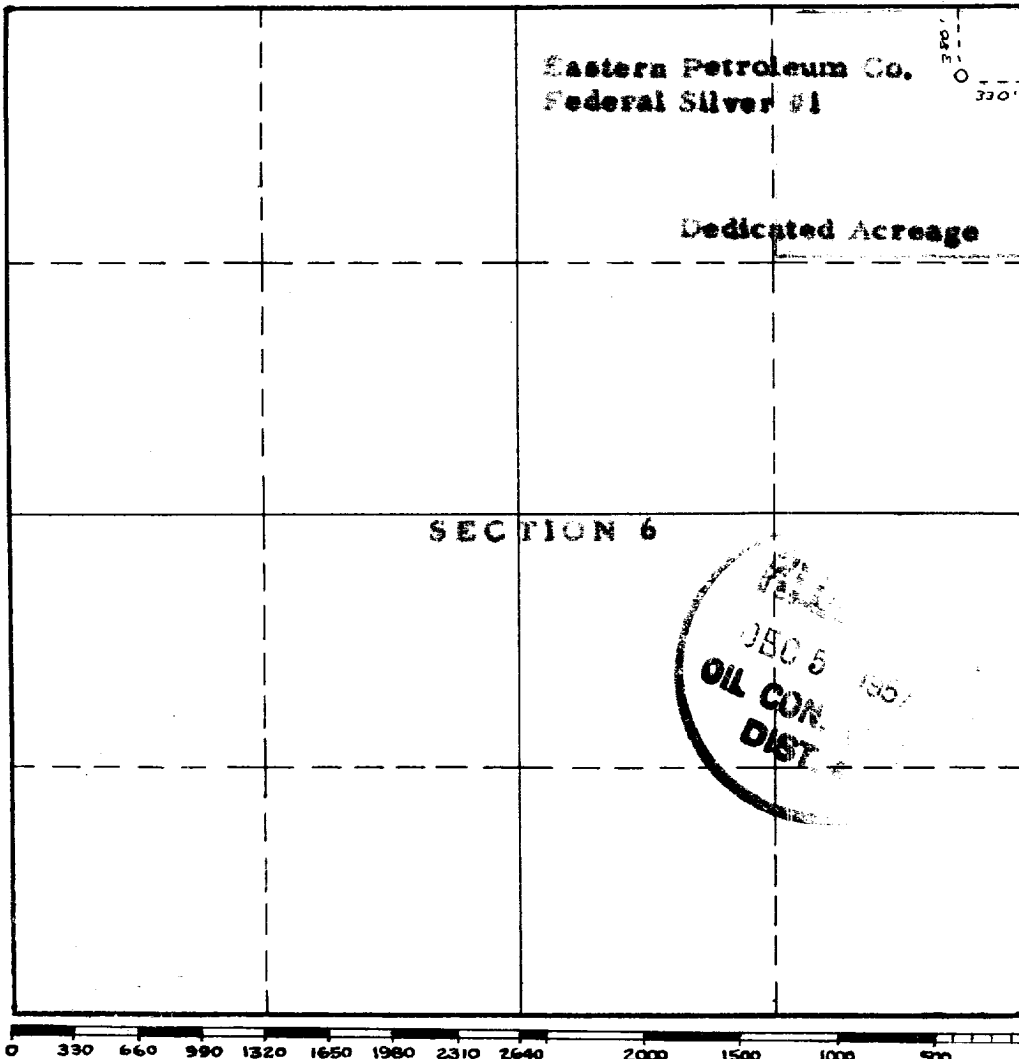
