Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your C. B. McElvain Government Well No. 1, to be located 1590 feet from the North line and 225 feet from the West line and in the SW/4 NW/4 of Section 23, Township 21 North, Range 2 West, Wildcat Pool, Sandoval County, New Mexico.
