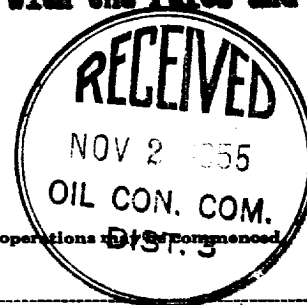
The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 7067.8 ft.

DETAILS OF WORK

It is proposed to drill a 8-1/4" hole with a rotary rig to the Entrada formation at a depth of approximately 7000'. Set approximately 250' of 10-1/4", 32.75#, N-40 surface casing and cement with approximately 180 sacks of cement. If commercial production is encountered, either 7", 23#, N-80 or 5 1/2", 15.50#, J-55 and 17#, N-80 casing will be run and cemented with approximately 250 sacks of cement.

All of the above work will be accomplished in keeping with the rules and regulations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Department.



I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations are commenced.

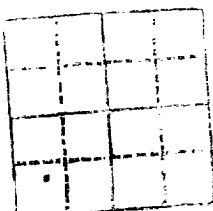

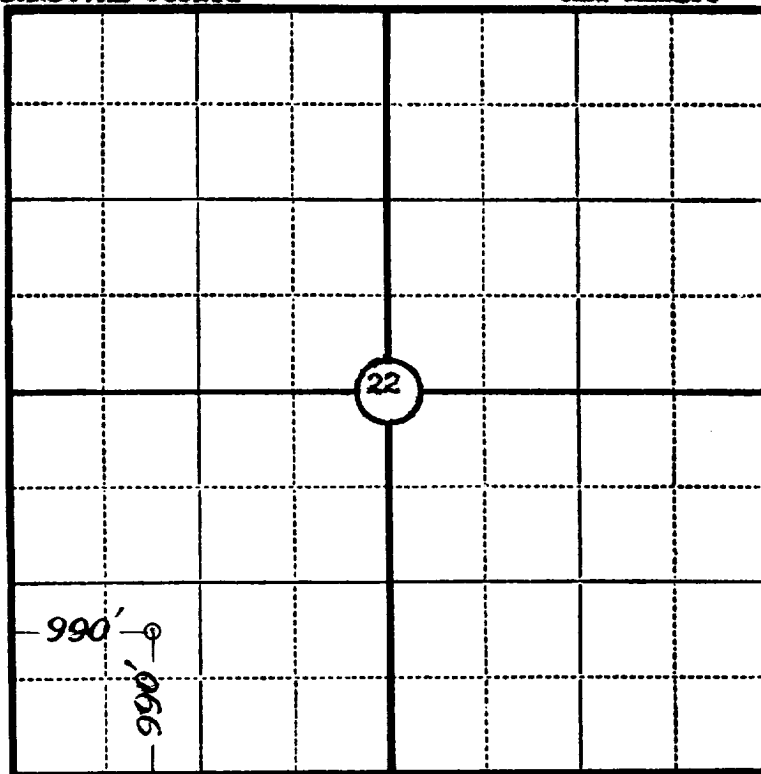
