Gentlemen:

With further reference to our conversation of this date concerning your Jicarilla-Apache Tribal Indians "B" 1-A 1-22H-5W, wildcat location, Sandoval County, we wish to advise that since this well is located in an area of the state in which there is no proration of oil by units, no supplement to the proration schedule can be issued or will be necessary. The only authority which you will need to produce the oil from this well and to transport it to the Malco Refining Plant will be an approved copy of Form C-104 and Form C-110. The amount of oil that can be produced is not limited to the daily or monthly allowable.
